

Centre Trials Championship

Below are the proposals for changes to the current Championship which will be effective from 2018. The Chairman, Tony Noel, has extended an invitation to the next Board Meeting 11th September, The Gala Club, Fairmile Gardens, Gloucester, to discuss this further or to suggest amendments. This is a subject that has been discussed at Board Meetings for several months and a decision must be made before the dates meeting in October.

THE PROPOSAL

A simple route based Championship, possible expert, clubman expert, clubman, sportsman plus and sportsman with each route riding for it's own championship. At the end of the year the winner will move up, or stay on their current route for no award (applicable for 2 years). An age related championship to take place on the clubman route for those riders over 40. (These riders would not be required to move up at the end of the year.) Youth Championships to stay as they are as it encourages progression. No twinshock or pre 65 Championship.

10 rounds to be run (if possible) with 9 to count.
