Classes/Routes

Classes are as per Championship Rules.

1. Ladies Championship Class and Girls A Class. Marked with pairs of White flags.

2. Ladies Intermediate and Girls B Marked with Blue on left and Red on right flags.

3. Girls C Marked with pairs of Yellow flags.

4. Girls D Marked with pairs of Pink flags.

Non-Championship Classes: Riders wishing to ride in a class other than their age group may do so on a "no points, no award" basis. (Shown as '-' below.)

Entries

Methods: Online entries must be made via the ACU Members system. A direct link will be found on the event's webpage on ACU Western <u>website</u>.

Entry Fee: **£35** for either **individual day** or **£60** for **both**.

Note: Fee includes cost of an assistant (Over 18yrs and **Not on Motorcycle**, will need to sign-on with rider and wear the provided identification.)

Entries are limited to 100 by order of receipt and will open as shown on the ACU Events calendar and close Thursday 29th August 23:00.

Entry Fees will only be returned if the event is cancelled or postponed.

Bikes

Must be as per The <u>Trials Standing Regulations</u> for each age category.

Start Time

Riders' starting order will be by **order of entry receipt** and grouped in each class.

Riders, Assistants and Marshals Briefing will be at 10:00am each day.

First Rider Starts at 10:30am and one per minute thereafter.

Remember you will need to be scrutineered and signed on at least 30 mins prior to your start time. An overall time limit of 5 hours will apply from the actual time the rider starts with 1 mark per minute for lateness, at both Start and Einish, up to a max

for lateness, at both Start and Finish, up to a max 20mins before exclusion.

A digital clock, at start and finish, will show official time.

Sections

3 Laps of 12 Sections are planned.

Standard trials marking will be used throughout – 0,1,2,3,5.(10) Trial is a <u>no-stopping trial (TSR22B)</u>.

Quantity and laps will be confirmed on the day and explained at Riders' briefing.

Riders must only have their registered minder in the section or, when required, the assistance of another minder who has signed on. Anyone found to have additional helpers in the section will be excluded.

Results

Will be available on the ACU Western website (acuwesterncentre.org.uk) and on ACUTrialGB.org.uk when confirmed.

A display board at the end of the lap will show accumulated scores as Punch Cards come in.

Note: If you (and we!) can access the Internet then over the weekend results will be posted throughout the day as-and-when Punch Cards come in after each lap, and as often as possible. <u>The Event's Page</u>.

Results will be announced on the day with a 30 min period for protest and published as soon as possible after.

Awards

Will be awarded for $1^{st},\,2^{nd}$ and 3^{rd} in each championship class.

Disciplinary Action

Riders are reminded that any abusive or threatening behaviour towards officials, including harassment of observers, is in breach of ACU 11.01.7. This also applies to any member of the rider's entourage, including parents and guardians of youth riders.

A Yellow Card system may be used – If so, it will be confirmed in Final instructions.

Data Protection (GDPR)

Riders and Parents/Carers should be aware that when you enter competitions your contact information may be collected and shared with other ACU event Organisers/ACU Head Office/ ACU Local Centre as detailed on the entry form. More details are available on the main ACU website.

Filming

Riders may be filmed during the event. Please talk to the media crew if you do not wish to be.
