THE EVENT A Time and Observation Pudding Noshing at the 1984 Western Centre Party, deferred from its traditional venue at the Bulls Head, Craswall, in order to accommodate the overwhelming demand by Western Centre Members to have the opportunity of showing the rest of the Country just how generous they can be. Entry is by invitation only.

THE GENERAL CONSTITUTION RULES OF P. I. G. S. (The Pudding and Intestine Gorgers Society) and the following Supplementary Regulations shall apply. The interpretation of these G. C. R.'s and S. R.'s (plus any others he may think appropriate to the action in progress) shall be at the Promoters discretion. BEING FINAL and with NO APPEALS ALLOWED!!! A P. I. G. S. Competition Licence must be shown by each Competitor at the Start

1) CONDITIONS OF ENTRY Each Competitor must be firmly under the control of a fully qualified and licenced P. I. G. S. Entrant/Manager who will be solely responsible for all misdemeanours of their Entry, and must be financially supported by not less than four Sponsors. The Entrant/Manager and the Sponsors shall be jointly responsible for the payment of all Fees, Penalties, Fines, Etc., incurred by their Competitor. The Sponsors will be at liberty to raise Funds from any source. EXCEPT THE PROMOTERS!

2) ENTRY FEE The Entrant of each Competitor must raise a minimum sum of £2.00 in Sponsorship Fees before their Competitor commences the Qualifying Section.

3) AWARDS The Title 'CHAMPION PUDDING SUFFER OF THE YEAR' and the Trophy (to be held for one year) shall be awarded to the Competitor who loses least marks in accordance with the Promoters interpretation of these G. C. R.'s and S. R.'s. Other awards such as Blinousness, Indigestion, and the Sh will be awarded at the discretion of the weaker Competitors stomachs.

4) CLASSIFICATION One Unlimited Capacity Class shall operate in each Competitor being provided with a measured portion of the Sacrificial Pudding in accordance with S. R. 5.

5) WEIGHT/VOIUME RATIO of the Sacred Substance. The original 'Pure' weight as at the time of removal from the deep freeze will apply in all cases. Given that there will have been a total lack of temperature control since that time, 09.00hrs 9th December 1984, any additional appendages, i.e., Green Mould, Ringi, Maggots, etc., will be deemed to be an 'Act of God' and all such garnishing must be consumed. Note S.R. 17.

6) QUALIFICATION A short 'Qualifying Section' must be 'Cleaned' before the Start. Marks will be lost for lack of Technique, Style, Decorum, Nerve, or plain Cowardice. Failure to complete the Qualifying Section will almost certainly incur the wrath of the Sponsors as it will attract a FINE OF ONE POUND.

7) TIME SCHEDULE An overall time of 9 hours 43 minutes 27.5 seconds will apply.

8) TIME PENALTIES For every One Minute after the first Ten Minutes the Contestants shall loose one mark. Any Contestant still in conflict after Fifteen minutes shall buy his Sponsors a round of Drinks. RETIREMENT may be applied for on a £5 note.

9) OBSERVATION shall be controlled by the Promoters whistle. All activity must cease immediately the whistle is blown and must not continue until the whistle is blown again to indicate the Re-Start.

10) HANDICAPPING may be applied at the Promoters discretion. Bribery will almost certainly distort the Promoters sense of Fair Play in this case.

- 11) FOOTING will be recorded if a chewing motion is not maintained once commenced.
- 12) A STOP shall have occurred if a Competitor shows rapid changes of colour, rolling of the eyes, profuse sweating, slides off his chair, or in any way fails to maintain good 'Forward Motion'. DEATH shall NOT be considered an acceptable reason for failure to complete the Course, devious acts of this nature shall be adjudged to be 'Conduct Prejudicial to the Sport' and a penalty of £10.00 shall be enforced forthwith.
- 13) OUTSIDE ASSISTANCE Force feeding by Entrants, Managers, Sponsors, Meat Mechanics, or Helpful Friends(?), will be allowed at a charge of £1.00 per minute.
- 14) DRINKING during the Competition is strictly forbidden. Any offender will be penalised by drinking one pint of warm milk before being allowed to Re-Start.
- 15) PRACTICING is PROHIBITED within the confines of the Venue.
- 16) UNGENTLEMANELY CONDUCT The placing of any substance, edible or not, on a Rivals plate will not be tolerated and will probably be rewarded with a Punch up the Hooter from the offended Party in addition to the statutory loss of 20 marks.
- 17) COMPULSORY SAFETY EQUIPMENT One Welly or Riding Boot must be provided by each Competitor to restrict the excess's of regurgitation. Any Competitor guilty of such misconduct shall have his Membership of P.I.G.S. immediately terminated and shall be expelled from the Venue with all possible haste. Re-entry will only be allowed subject to an undertaking by his Sponsors to pay a sum of Ten Pounds in the event of any further tarnishing of the Good Name and Reputation of P.I.G.S.
- 18) PROTESTS which will be encouraged, are to be lodged with the Promoter plus a £1.00 fee during the Contest or up to five minutes after the First Man finishes. The Protest Fee will be forfeited. Marks will be adjusted per pro the size of Bribe offered.
- 19) BETTING to be known as 'Sponsoring' will be positively encouraged and expected from everyone within sight or sound of this Magnificent Spectacle.
- 20) REVERSE PENALTY CLAUSE The Competitor with the greatest number of marks lost at the end of the Event shall have his marks reduced by 10% in recognition of the dire for him to conceal his Gross Incompetence from his Sponsors.
