Sportsman plus route (ride half the clubman sections and half sportsman sections)

Sportsman route marked with yellow markers.

Conducted route for Youth C, D and E

(In accordance with Western centre guidelines)

Solo Adults of Intermediate and Novice status. Note – Riders over the age of 40 should state "OVER 40" on their entry form. (Example "Novice over 40"). Youth A, B and C can ride the main course. There will also be a separate conducted course for Youth C, D and E riders.

Experts can ride on a no award basis. The classes that are eligible for the Western Centre Clubman Championship are -
