Description of the event

The Club will hold an open trial at Farmcote, near Winchcombe Glos.

The start will be signposted from the High Street in Winchcombe and from the B4077 just West of Ford. The trial will be open to affiliated members of an ACU club and will be run under non-stop rules as per TSR-22B in accordance with the National Sporting Code, the standing regulations for trials of the Auto Cycle Union (Ltd), the following supplementary regulations and any final instructions to riders that may be issued on the day of the event. There is no expert route but experts can ride on a no award basis.

Respect for Observers

Breaches of rules NSC 11.01.2 (attempt to influence an observer) and 11.01.7 (violent / abusive behaviour towards an observer) will result in exclusion and naming and shaming in the results.

Solo Adults of Intermediate and Novice status. Note – Riders over the age of 40 should state “OVER 40” on their entry form. (Example “Novice over 40”)

Youths of A, B and C class can ride on the main route. The sportsman route will be suitable for twinshocks and P65 bikes.
