Clubman Route. Marked with Red (Right) and Blue (Left) markers.

Adults of Expert , Intermediate and Novice Status. Note- Riders over the age of 40/50/60 should state " OVER 40/50/60 " on their entry forms. (Example " Novice over 40 ") Youth A and B class only.
