Classes 1, 2, 4, 5, 6 & 10.

Route/Course Options

Expert route: – Red (right) and Blue (left) with pairs of White Markers for Deviation.
Clubman Expert :- (50/50) identified by a sign at the start of the section.
Clubman route: – Red (right) and Blue (left) markers.
Sportsman route: – Red (right) and Blue (left) with Pairs of Yellow markers for Deviation.
(In accordance with the ACU Western guidelines)
