Expert Route route variation marked with pairs of white markers  
Clubman/Expert (50/50) route identified by a sign at the start of the section  
Clubman route marked with Red & Blue markers  
Sportsman Plus (50/50) route identified by a sign at the start of the section  
Sportsman route variation marked with pairs of yellow markers

(In accordance with Western centre guidelines)

Expert. Intermediate, Novice, Over 40, Over 50, Over 60, Youth A, B, C, Ladies, Twinshock, Pre 65

Entries

Entries must be made via the ACU on line web site.

## **Covid 19 Safety.**

Please read ALL of this message. These rules must be adhered to in order for the event to remain safe and follow all government guidelines.

Anyone who experiences or has experienced COVID-19 symptoms within 14 days prior to the event must not attend.

We have introduced these processes to ensure that everyone remains the required social distance at all times. It is solely your responsibility to keep 2m social distancing rule.

Please can we ask that you do not travel without a confirmed entry. If you have not entered then you will not be allowed to enter the parking area. We are using the ACU Online Event system for all entries. NO telephone, postal or Emailed entries will be allowed.

There will be NO entry on the day, NO cash transactions.

Car parking spaces have been created with social distancing guidelines in mind; please ensure you park where instructed.

As per government guidelines, riders must only travel with one other household who are riding and have been entered. Strictly one rider to one bike.

Signing on your numbers will be posted to you once your entry has been confirmed. You will need to bring these to the event and show them to the secretary of the meeting to confirm your attendance.

Please can we ask that you do not congregate with other riders whilst at the venue. Everyone on site must follow social distancing of at least 2 metres apart whilst at our venue.

Face Masks must be worn at all times unless, riding a section.

Once you registered you arrive with the secretary return to your vehicle until the start of the event which will be signalled via a car horn.

No more than 3 people at any one time to walk the section (in one direction only), exit the section at the end and return to your machine. Do NOT walk back down the section.

Maximum of 6 people to queue at a section at a spacing of 2m. If there are already 6 people in the queue either stop and wait or proceed to the next section.

If a marker flag is dislodged the rider is responsible for replacing it at the direction of the observer.

Do NOT approach the Observer

**Finally please follow all advice and instructions from our officials without question or hostility. Anyone found flouting these rules will be asked to leave. We are trying to run a safe and enjoyable event whilst maintaining all government guidelines. Your efforts in helping us achieve this will be greatly appreciated.**
