The Trial will be run under the No Stop Permitted Marking System (TSR 22B).

EXPERT (HARD) ROUTE: marked with pairs of white markers when deviating from Clubman Route.

CLUBMAN EXPERT ROUTE: with indication at 'Section Begins' markers.

CLUBMAN ROUTE: marked with Red (Right) and Blue (Left) markers.

SPORTSMAN PLUS: with indication at 'Section Begins' markers.

SPORTSMAN ROUTE: marked with pairs of yellow markers when deviating from Clubman Route.

Awards

EXPERT (HARD) ROUTE: Best Performance, First Class awards to next best 10% of starters on the route, Best Intermediate, Best Over40, Best Youth A, Best WVAC member resident in Herefordshire.*

CLUBMAN EXPERT ROUTE: Best Intermediate, Best Youth A, Best Over40.

CLUBMAN ROUTE: Best Novice, Best Over40, Best Youth A/B.

SPORTSMAN PLUS ROUTE: Best Novice, Best Over50, Best Youth B/C.

SPORTSMAN ROUTE: Best Novice, Best Over60, Best Youth C.

Note: A RIDER MUST ONLY ENTER ONE CLASS!!!

All above awards are subject to a **minimum** of three starters in each class on each route.

* The WVAC award will revert to the 50/50 Route, then the following routes down if not awarded on the Expert Route.
