Route / Course options

Expert. (Hard) Route: marked with pairs of white markers when deviating from clubman route

Clubman Expert Route (50/50) route marked at section begins

Clubman Route : marked with Red (Right) and Blue (Left) markers

Sportsman Plus route riders will ride the clubman route where marked at beginning of the sections comprising of a mixture of sportsman and clubman sections

Sportsman route variation marked with pairs of yellow markers when deviating from Clubman Route

Riders Numbers two must be displayed at all times. (as per Western Centre guidelines)

Class Options

Solo Adults of Expert , Intermediate and Novice status. Note – Riders over the age of 40 should state “OVER 40” on their entry form. (Example “Novice over 40”) Youths of A;B;C; D can ride Sportsman Route.

Riders Numbers two must be displayed at all times. (as per Western Centre guidelines)

NOTE Entrants should complete the option box on the online entry as to which type of award they wish to receive!!
