Route / Course options

There will be one route entirely on private land which all team members shall ride, however there will be deviations for Pre 65 machines. Sections will be of a varied standard with the emphasis being on testing the Novice riders in the team. A special test will be used to determine any tied scores.

Proposed format

Teams shall be drawn by the clerk of the course before the start from the entered riders. The team will consist of one Leader of Expert, Intermediate, or Experienced Youth A status and two or more Novice / Youth status riders. The average score of the team shall determine the final result. Riders that retire shall be allocated a score equal to the highest score of the day.

Note – Teams of 3, or more, riders can pre enter but on a "No award" basis.

Class Options

Solo Adults of Expert, Intermediate and Novice status. Note – Riders over the age of 40 should state "OVER 40" on their entry form. (Example "Novice over 40") Youths of A and B class only.

Awards

Best Team --- The John Husband Memorial Trophy. Best Pre 65 Team --- An award Individual award for best overall performance.
