Route/ Course Options.

**ACU Western Youth, and the G&C club, championship is a class based championship spread across all routes
Entrants can choose to ride any one of the following routes.**

Expert route. Marked with pairs of white markers

Club / Expert route. (50/50) route identified at Section Begins

Club Route. Marked with Red (Right) and Blue (Left) markers.

Sports plus route (50/50) route identified at Section Begins.

Sports route Marked with pairs of yellow markers

Conducted route Marked with Red (Right) and Blue (Left) markers for basic and pairs of yellow markers for hard deviations. {may include variations of the Sports route}

Note This Trial will be Run under TSR22A Stop permitted Rules.

Class Options.

Solo motorcycles only with all Adult and all Youth classes,

Awards over the 3 rounds

Best Performance on each route,

Over all the routes ; -Best G&C member, Best Youth A,B,C, Best Female rider.

Best Over 50 (Sports plus route)

Subject to a minimum of 3 entrants in the class.

Entries

Entries are **limited to 80** and must be made in advance on line using the Sport 80 platform

Entry fee of £20 for Adults, and £15 for Youths.
